In 1849, Shem published the fourth German edition  
of the Märtyrer Spiegel ("Martyrs Mirror"). The 987-  
page volume's title page states that it was printed in  
Philadelphia by King and Baird and "PUBLISHED BY SHEM  
ZOOK, NEAR LEWISTOWN, MIFFLIN COUNTY, PA." Because  
of improved typesetting methods, this edition became  
smaller and more compact than previous editions,  
weighing only 6 ½ pounds or half that of the first German  
edition printed at Ephrata in 1748-1749. The 1849 edition  
was also the first to make any major language changes  
in the original Ephrata text. The preface states: "A man  
of undoubted ability not only guided the printing of this  
work but also noticeably improved the language and  
style." Whether that person was Shem himself or his  
talented brother David is not known. One might speculate  
that both assisted in the venture.

By 1849, when Shem published his edition of the  
Märtyrer Spiegel, the Amish settlement in Kishacoquillas  
Valley consisted of three congregations or districts: Lower,  
Middle, and Upper. Solomon Beiler, who was the bishop in  
the Middle District. That Shem shared Beiler's viewpoint  
is apparent from his inclusion of a certain picture on  
the 1849 Märtyrer Spiegel's second division title page.  
The illustration depicts the baptism of Jesus by John the  
Baptist and shows both standing in the Jordan River. While  
the scene may or may not be historically correct, the fact  
that Shem chose to use it reveals how he felt about the  
baptismal controversy in his community. The picture had  
not been included in any previous editions or, for that  
matter, in any later printings.
